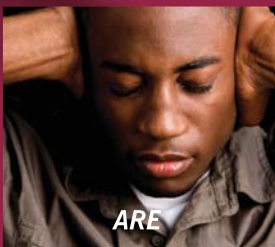

commonly referred in for our help are for those. . .

- in search of hope, healing, and change.
- experiencing a deeper walk and new life with God.
- facing parenting, family, marital, and relationship difficulties, and/or communication breakdown.
- facing the painful aftermath of a life altering experience - still crippling their capabilities today.
- needing help and new skills to resolve anger, conflict, bitterness, and to address unforgiveness issues.
- grieving a loss of a loved one from divorce, death, or a drastic life change in circumstances.
- suffering post abortion trauma/post adoption, or other infant death/loss, and emotionally shaken.

Parenting and Life Skills

- One-on-one help is regularly available. Classes are scheduled periodically according to need and the availability of resources and leadership.

Crisis Pregnancies

We help each individual, couple, and/or extended family in evaluating their options regarding an unplanned pregnancy.

We provide:

- Accurate on-site, free pregnancy tests.
- Educational information to assess the options re: pregnancy, parenting, abortion, adoption, and follow up. Goal: to make an informed decision and plan of care.
- Counsel consideration of the influential issues creating crisis in the pregnancy, and their resolve.
- Material Assistance & Practical Supports. Referrals to other supports & agencies.

Community Partnership

We welcome community partnerships for filling gaps in services, meeting needs, and providing free assistance to families and individuals in community, who lack the means or transportation to get services elsewhere.

Mentoring Classes

For those who would benefit from friendship, support, earning and learning new life-skills, budgeting, parenting, cooking, etc., and our resource room dollars.
