


SOUTH NIAGARA LIFE MINISTRIES 3rd QUARTER NEWSLETTER

10:00 to 12:00 to the end of November. Come when you can through to the end of November - when another focus, after a short break for Christmas, will be offered.


All are welcome-as are your friends. Each week, for now, we will consider a name and character trait of God, to discuss or Q&A. For all ages

FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESK

John 1: 35-41

The following day, John was standing with two of his disciples. As Jesus walked by, John looked at him and declared, "Look! There is the Lamb of God!" When John's two disciples heard this, they followed Jesus.

Jesus looked around and saw them following. "What do you want?" he asked them. They replied, "Rabbi (which means Teacher), where are you staying? "Come and see" he said. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon when they went with him to the place where he was staying, and they remained with him the remainder of the day.

Andrew, Simon Peter's brother was one of these men who heard what John said and then followed Jesus. Andrew went to find his brother, Simon and told him, "We have found the Messiah" (which means Christ).

There is an interesting pattern in this text. John the Baptist was standing by with two of his disciples, and when he sees Jesus, he proclaims — "Look! There is the Lamb of God." John the Baptist functions like the counselor whose role is to point the client seeking help to Jesus. And in the Biblical text, John's disciples started following Jesus. The counselor's goal is to assist the client in becoming followers of Jesus. The next point in the pattern is when Jesus asks them — "what do you want?" The simple response is — "where are you staying?" In addition to "following Jesus" they want to be with Jesus and He invites them to "come and see". The role of the counselor is to help clients discover how they can spend time with Jesus (the disciples in our text spent the whole day with Jesus) and the third part of the pattern is that Andrew; one of the disciples of John the Baptist, goes to his brother (Peter) and quietly says — "We have found the Messiah". In spending time with Jesus, Andrew now understands the fullness of who he is and this compels him to tell his brother.

I share these three steps because they are essential to developing our client base at South Niagara Life Ministries. We need to not only be pointing clients to Jesus and helping them to grow in the knowledge of Jesus, but we want our clients to be telling others about Jesus, and how South Niagara Life Ministries helped them.

It is very interesting to note that much of SNLM's clients come because of "word of mouth". According to our statistics, the majority of our clients are referred to South Niagara Life Ministries by their Church pastor, previous clients, or friends. This tells us that word of mouth is very important. I want to take this opportunity to thank every who has been telling others about the wonderful things that the Lord is doing through South Niagara Life Ministries. Keep spreading the news and inviting people to "come and see".


